





# Affordable Tuition

Tuition fees in the Philippines are affordable when compared to countries like the UK, Canada, or the US. This makes it possible for families to plan properly and support their children through university without excessive financial pressure.



- **₦700,000 – ₦1,400,000 per semester**  
**(Approx. \$900 – \$1,800)**
- **Depending on the course, school, and number of enrolled units.**

**Medical-related and aviation courses cost more**

***\*Usually 4-5 Months per semester***



# Faster Admission

Admission in the Philippines follows a clear and structured process. Once academic requirements are met, students do not need to **wait** months before starting school. You will receive your admission letter within weeks of application.

# Globally Recognised Degrees

Degrees awarded by accredited universities in the Philippines are globally recognised. Graduates can pursue further studies or career opportunities in other countries if they choose to do so.



# About the Philippines

A safe and welcoming environment for students



**The Philippines is a country in Southeast Asia that has become a popular destination for **international students** over the years.**

**One reason is that it is generally safe and very student friendly. Nigerian students find it easy to settle in, interact with locals, and adapt to the environment.**

# Low cost of living

Another important factor is the cost of living. Compared to many other study destinations, daily expenses such as accommodation, food, and transportation are quite **affordable**.

In addition to this, students enjoy **stable electricity**, fast and **cheap internet**, reliable water supply, and functional public services. These everyday conveniences make studying easier and allow students to focus on their academics without constant disruption or financial pressure on their families.



**On average, a student can live comfortably in the Philippines on about ₱250,000 per month, covering accommodation, food, transportation, electricity, and internet, depending on lifestyle and city.**



# Strong international student community

The Philippines also has a strong international student community. Students from Africa, Asia, the Middle East, and other regions study there, creating a diverse and supportive environment. For Nigerian students, this sense of community makes the transition smoother and less intimidating.

# How the Application Process Works

# Application Steps

Step 1

## **SUBMIT INITIAL ADMISSION DOCUMENTS**

WAEC or NECO original result, SS1 to SS3 school transcript, passport data page, birth certificate, secondary school testimonial

Step 2

## **PAY SCHOOL ADMISSION FEE (₦150,000)**

Once documents are reviewed and accepted, the student pays the school's official admission fee of ₦150,000. This payment allows the university to begin processing the admission.

# Application Steps

Step 3

## **RECEIVE ADMISSION LETTER (NOA)**

After approval, the university issues the student's Admission Letter, also known as the Notice of Admission. This letter is then sent to the Department of Foreign Affairs in the Philippines for Apostille, previously called the Red Ribbon.

Step 4

## **FULL PROCESSING AND DFA AUTHENTICATION**

At this stage, full processing is completed in the Philippines. This includes ₱1,500,000 for school processing and DFA authentication, and ₱60,000 for international shipping. The complete admission package is then sent to Nigeria.

# Application Steps

Step 5

## **ABUJA DOCUMENT AUTHENTICATION (OPTIONAL SUPPORT)**

Before embassy submission, documents are authenticated at the Federal Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Abuja. Students may choose optional assistance at a cost of ₦500,000 to help manage this process.

Step 6

## **EMBASSY DOCUMENT PREPARATION**

All student, sponsor, and travel documents are prepared for embassy submission. The embassy visa fee at this stage is ₦488,000, paid directly to the Philippine Embassy.

Step 7

## VISA APPROVAL AND TRAVEL PREPARATION

Once the visa is approved, students collect their visa and receive guidance on flight booking, departure planning, and travel arrangements to the Philippines.

## ARRIVAL IN PHILIPPINES
